If the UST is being installed in a flood-prone area or an area where the highest anticipated groundwater level is above the depth of the bottom of the UST then detailed plans on the method that will be used to protect the UST from floatation must be provided.

Signature Requirements: The licensee, or their representative, installing or removing the UST **must** sign this application.

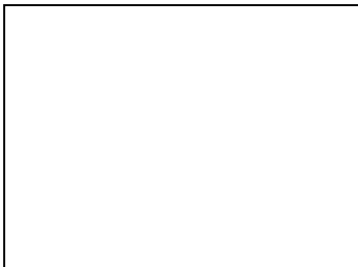
